# Queen Vicki's Wristlets

## Elegant and refined — these wristlets are a great beginner lace project.

#### **Finished measurements:**

Wristlet circumference: 6.5 [7, 7.5, 8] inches around hand just below fingers Wristlet length: as you like it **Materials:** 

✓ 1 ball (50g) of fingering weight yarn.
We recommend: Filatura di Crosa
Zarina (100% superfine merino wool,



164m/50g ball), Diamond Luxury Footloose (90% merino, 10% nylon, 175m/50g ball), and/or Mirasol Nuna (40% merino wool, 40% silk, 20% bamboo sourced viscose, 175m/50g).

- ✓ 3.0 3.5 straight needles
- ✓ 1 wool needle (for seaming)

#### Gauge:

24 stitches and 36 rows over 4 inches on 3mm needle in stocking stitch

#### Instructions:

Cast on 42 [46, 50, 54] stitches loosely.

#### For both hands:

Work 3 rows of garter stitch (knit every stitch on every row). Next row: P1, \*yop, P2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, P1. Work 3 rows of garter stitch.

#### **Right hand**

Row 1 and all odd numbered rows: Knit 20 [23, 26, 29], follow the lace chart for 17 stitches, knit 5 [6, 7, 8].

Row 2 and all even rows: K1, purl 40 [44, 48, 52], K1.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until desired length achieved, finishing with a row 1 of the lace chart (store

sample has 6 pattern repeats plus a Row 1).

Work 3 rows of garter stitch.

While every effort has been made to have these pattern instructions accurate and complete, we cannot be responsible for variance in individual crafters, human errors or typographical mistakes.

Next row: Next row: K1, \*yo, K2tog, repeat from \* to last stitch, K1.

Work 3 rows of garter stitch, then bind off all stitches (using picot bind off if desired).

#### Picot Bind Off:

Bind off 1 stitch, transfer stitch on right needle back to left hand needle. \*\*Cast on 2 stitches using cable cast on method. Bind off 4 stitches (one at a time), transfer stitch on right needle to left hand needle. Continue from \*\* until all stitches are bound off.

#### Left hand


Follow as per right hand, starting with a knit 5 [6, 7, 8], inserting 17 stitches of lace chart and then knit 20 [23, 26, 29].

### Finishing

Wash in cold water with Eucalan or Soak and block until dry. (Note: with lace you will have the ability to stretch out if you need a larger size. You will want to open up the lace so that you can see the pattern)

Sew from top down 2.5 cm. Leave a 3 cm opening for the thumb hole (or size desired) and sew to bottom.

#### **Knitting Abbreviations:**

K = knit P = purl K2tog = knit 2 together P2tog = purl 2 together LHN = left hand needle RHN = right hand needle st(s) = stitch(es)

**SSK** = slip next two stitches one at a time knitwise from the LHN to the RHN. Insert the tip of the LHN into the front of the slipped stitches and knit together

**SK2P** = slip next stitch purlwise, knit next 2 sts together, then pass the slipped stitch over the K2tog stitch (double decrease) **yo** = bring the yarn forward between the needles from the back to the front, then over the top of the RHN needle for your next stitch.

**yop** = yarn over purlwise: wrap yarn over the top of the RHN, bringing it back to the front of your work for the next stitch

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
